E-FACTS

Ecstasy has become popular as a dance drug. Other dance drugs are Amphetamine sulphate powder, low dosages of L.S.D. and sometimes Cocaine.

Of the dance drugs proper E is most closely related to Amphetamine sulphate powder (whizz) and low dosage L.S.D.

One of the main problems with Ecstasy is buying a real one.

Recently in the North West the following drugs have been sold as Ecstasy.

- i) L.S.D. and Amphetamine Sulphate.
- ii) Methamphetamine.
- iii) Heroin and Amphetamine.
- iv) Ketamine - an anaesthetic drug used in surgery with very unpleasant side effects.

Little is known about how proper E affects the brain, but there is grieving evidence that too much, too often could cause problems.
